**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE ROUND
MOUNTAIN WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT RULES AND
REGULATIONS SECTION 2.3**

WHEREAS. The Round Mountain Water and Sanitation District (District) in accordance with section 32-11001(1)(m) of the Colorado Revised Statutes has the authority to amend existing Rules and Regulations when deemed necessary by the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is necessary to amend Section 2 (2.3) establishing stipulations and requirements for applicants acquiring connection permits on or after January 1, 2024 as noted on Appendix A of this resolution.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
ROUND MOUNTAIN WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT, COLORADO THAT:**

Effective January 1, 2024, this amendment of the District's Rules and Regulations "Section 2 (2.3)" as attached to this resolution be adopted and implemented.

APPENDIX A

Water and/or wastewater connection permits issued after January 1, 2024, shall not be subject to an expiration date, but will not be allowed to be returned to the District for a refund for any reason not approved by the District Board, including Federal or State actions and mandates that would prohibit (for an unknown period of time) the connection to District water and sewer mains. Once a tap purchase agreement is signed, the tap purchaser acknowledges and accepts the risks associated with that tap purchase.
